Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) 2025

Kia ora e te whānau

Blue Mountain College is a BYOD school from Year 7 - 13. This means that your child will need access to a laptop for school use. If they already have a Chromebook or similar (from primary school), that will be sufficient for their schooling till Year 9.

As the Chromebook is sufficient for Year 7 & 8, it is not necessary for a higher end laptop until Year 9. Below is information about what will be required for your child at Year 9 if you decide to get this instead of the chromebook.

The laptop would need to have the *Windows 10* operating system. We would also recommend a PC laptop over a Mac or Apple as PCs are more compatible with our school system for printing and other options. Attached are recommended laptops for Blue Mountain College students from [PB Tech](https://www.pbtech.co.nz). Otherwise, we recommend the following specifications below:

- Windows 10 (preferred operating system)
- At least an i5/2.2GHZ Processor or equivalent.
- 8GB of RAM minimum
- 124GB SSD storage recommended
- Wireless capability and keyboard
- A minimum of 6-hour battery life

Students can download Word, PowerPoint etc. free from their school email at Office 365. We can show them how to do this. For accessing assistive technology, we recommend students bring headphones daily.

The laptop will be the responsibility of the student. It is recommended that devices are covered by insurance for accidental damage; although, there are lockers available for storage during break times. Also, it is recommended to have a robust case.

We realise that purchasing a laptop is not financially possible for all our families. If this is your situation, please contact the school for alternative arrangements to be made on an individual basis.
